I did... during the first three days. But it was a mixture of a lot of medicines – from “Moment”, to “Oki”, to “Tachipirina”... it would have been better to use only one.

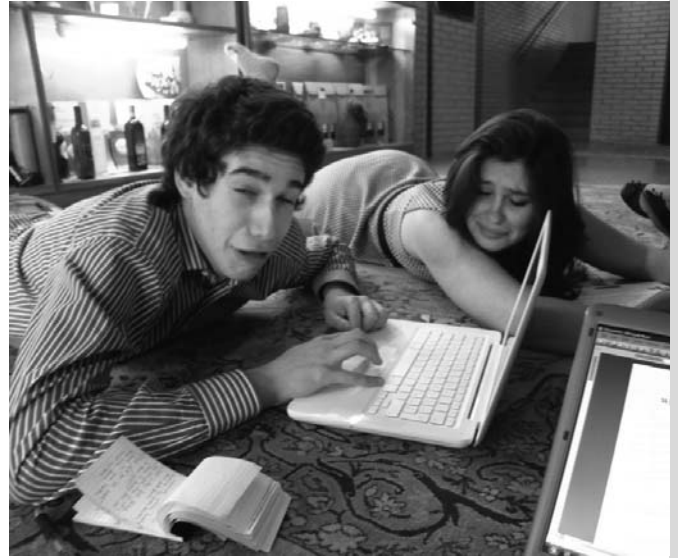
How did the delegates accept the fact that you weren't present all the time?

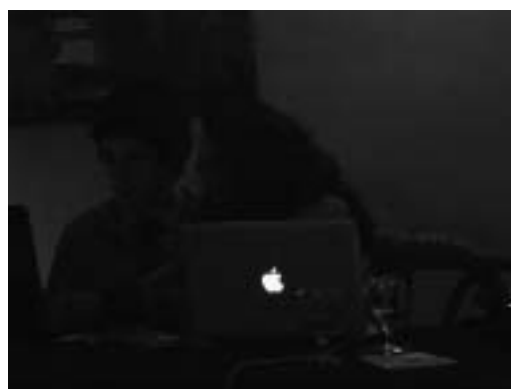
1. Take yesterday's issue and today's...can you find one single article by one of the two which has not been written in pair with the other one? Isn't it a bit suspicious?

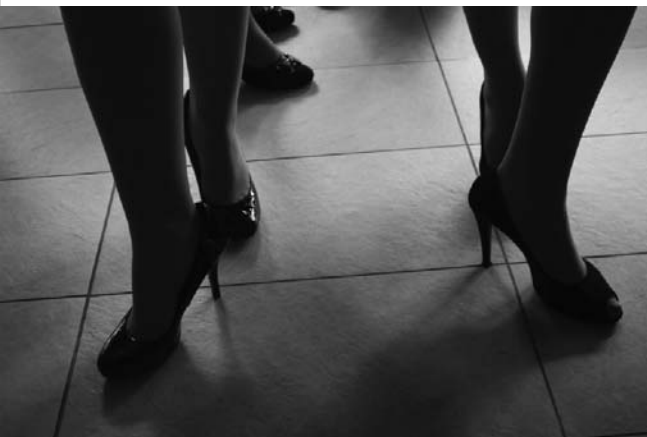
## Sky high
